### NOLS Teton Valley Winter Trip

We look forward to meeting you at the start of your trip. We hope the following information will help you get here with a minimum of difficulty and expense.

#### Air Travel

**Where:** Fly to Idaho Falls, Idaho

**When:** Schedule your incoming flight to arrive the night before your trip start date. Schedule your return flight to depart on the day after your trip end date.

#### Hotel Accommodations in Idaho Falls

Participants who fly to Idaho Falls will need to spend the night prior to the trip start date and the night of the trip end date in a hotel. We recommend staying at the **Best Western Cottontree Inn**. Ask for NOLS rate. Reservations: **1-800-662-6886, ext. 7**. Please make your reservations at least one week in advance.

#### Group shuttle from Idaho Falls to NOLS Teton Valley via Teton Stage Lines

Reserve a seat with Teton Stage Lines (TSL) on the 7:30 a.m. shuttle from the Cottontree Inn to NOLS Teton Valley. **Reservations-1-800-285-8036**. The TSL shuttle bus will meet you outside the Cottontree Inn's front door. Please make reservations at least one week in advance. You can pay by phone or in person. You will also have book your return to the Cottontree from Driggs on the final evening.

#### Driggs Lodging

If you want to come early / stay late to ski and thus need a place to stay in Driggs, we recommend the hostel in downtown Driggs at <http://www.tetonhostel.com>, 208-354-5454. The Pines Motel is at the south end of town, 208-354-2774. There is also a Super 8 just north of town at 208-354-8888.

#### Driving Directions

The Teton Valley Branch is just south of Driggs, Idaho. From Driggs, drive south two miles on Hwy. 33. Turn left on 200 South. Drive almost two miles to a two story brick building on your left. That's us! From Jackson, Wyo., drive over Teton Pass. Continue north on Hwy. 33 towards Driggs. 1/4 mile past the drive-in theater (with a big potato parked out front) turn right on 200 South. Finish as above.

If you are driving plan to arrive at the Teton Valley Branch at 9 a.m. the day of your trip start date. This will coincide with the arrival of your trip mates on the shuttle from Idaho Falls. (Note: We do not have the staff or facilities to accommodate students who arrive earlier than the day before your trip begins. However there is a new hostel in Driggs—see below. Please help us in preparing for your course by arriving on time.)
