

# **Travel and Logistics Information**

## **Yellowstone Club Leadership Expedition**

### **July 25 – August 2, 2012**

We look forward to meeting you! Please read and then keep this information accessible, as it provides all of the logistical travel details for your course.

#### **Starting at NOLS Teton Valley (TVB), Driggs, Idaho**

- 1) Your course begins at NOLS Teton Valley.
- 2) You should plan to arrive at 5:00 p.m. the day before your official course start date, Tuesday, July 24, 2012.
- 3) Dinner will be served at 6:00 p.m.
- 4) You and your course mates will spend the night of July 24 at NOLS TVB and depart for the field on Wednesday, July 25 after gear and rations are issued.

#### **Ending at TBD Road-head**

- 1) Your course will be met by NOLS staff at a TBD road-head on the morning of Thursday, August 2, 2012.
- 2) Students will de-issue gear and have a final lunch together.
- 3) The course officially ends at noon at which time Yellowstone Club will pick up students at a TBD road-head. Parents are also welcome to pick-up their kids at the road-head.

#### **Potential Expenses**

Students should bring enough cash (~\$100) to cover personal expenses encountered traveling to and from NOLS TVB (i.e., meals). Everything else related to your course—including equipment rental or purchase — will be charged to your outfitting bill.

#### **Expedition Behavior Starts in Town**

You will learn much about what we call expedition behavior on your course. We expect you to demonstrate attention to the course, care for self, others, and property while at NOLS TVB as well as in the backcountry.

Collectively the group sets the tone for the course at an orientation meeting the evening you arrive. This gives you and your course mates a jumpstart on skills and expectations for the following day, when you expedition begins in earnest. The first morning's activities include checking personal gear, issuing NOLS equipment and food, and packing up to be driven to the trailhead.
