In its 2023 inaugural debut, the Innovation in Wilderness Risk Management Award recognizes an individual or organization in outdoor and adventure risk management that has positively impacted the industry. The award recipient should show evidence of driving innovation in wilderness risk management thinking or practice.	The Charles 'Reb' Gregg Leadership Award recognizes an individual for exceptional leadership, service, and dedication to the outdoor education and adventure professions. This award is presented to an individual who has made a lasting impact on risk management within the industry. Inspired by Reb's significant and progressive contributions to legal risk management for outdoor programs, the award highlights and honors extraordinary service in advancing the profession and knowledge base.
Selection criteria:  Demonstrate commitment to the WRMC community and the wilderness risk management profession.  Contributed recent professional innovation of thought or practice, such as approaches, research, tools, or techniques, that have the potential to evolve wider thinking and practice across the outdoor risk management field.  Demonstrated recent program- or organization-wide impact through innovation that has the potential to influence the profession across the greater WRMC community.
