The conference will be held at the *Holiday Inn Portland By the Bay*, 88 Spring St, Portland, ME04101. A limited number of discounted hotel rooms are available for attendees who book early. After all the WRMC discount hotel rooms have been reserved, lodging may be available at the conference hotel at a substantially higher rate.

ATTENDEE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How do I get to the conference hotel from the Portland International Jetport?

A: The Portland, Maine airport is just 4 miles from the conference venue. Complimentary shuttle service will be provided by the hotel. The Greater Portland METRO Route #7 will travel to and from the Portland Jetport into downtown Portland and is an affordable option for getting to/from the airport. - *Q: In the past, we registered as a group and received a discount. How do we do that this year?* A: The registration pricing structure simplified. There will not be a group discount.

Portland, ME LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

TRAILS

Eastern Promenade Trail: Located along Portland's waterfront! Easy to get to by going from the conference hotel to Commercial St. and heading east until you get to the cruise ship terminal/Sail Maine complex

Back Cove Trail: 5k loop around back bay. This also links with the Eastern Prom Trail

<u>Western Prom Trail/Mayor Baxter Woods:</u> A little further from the hotel, but still a great option!

FOOD

The <u>Portland Food Map</u> is an excellent comprehensive guide to view many of the amazing Portland food establishments!

<u>Standard Baking Company</u>: Portland's first French bakery, and James Beard Award Finalist. A truly top notch bakery and cafe, with fresh coffee always available.

<u>Cong Tu Bot</u>: Vietnamese food on Washington Ave. Washington Ave in general has a lot of great restaurants (<u>Terlingua</u> is another top choice!). There is also a distillery and brewery, so worth the trek across town (still only about a 20-25 minute walk from the hotel)

<u>The Honey Paw</u> or <u>Eventide</u>: Both amazing and popular choices for classic New England fare. These are located about a 15 minute walk from the hotel

Yosaku: a lovely Japanese restaurant right near the hotel

CAFÉS

Speckled Axe (on Congress or Thames): Congress is closer to the conference hotel, but if you find yourself walking along the Eastern Prom, the Thames location is perfect for picking up a coffee before or after your walk.

Bard Coffee: Excellent espresso and single-orgin brews
