### Travel, Meals, and Lodging

#### Meals and Lodging

No meals will be provided while students are in town. Students can either bring food of their own for lunch or, if they have access to a vehicle, drive into town to grab food from one of multiple nearby cafes about 10 minutes away from campus.

Camping and parking will be available at the NOLS Southwest Campus. The campus has a bathroom and showerhouse that campers will have access to, as well as a communal outdoor area with electricity and wifi, however that campsites themselves do not have any amenities or electricity. Folks can either park and sleep in their vehicle or set up a tent. Camping fees are \$7 per night. If you plan to camp on campus, please send an email to the Course Host with travel plans so we can be sure to be prepared for your arrival.

There is also a nearby area with public camping called Reddington Pass, about 20 minutes or so from campus.

For those interested, there are multiple nearby hotels, about 15-20 minutes away. The Comfort Suites on Tanque Verde and Sabino Canyon is a classic option and is known to offer a discount to NOLS students.

#### Travel

The NOLS Southwest campus is located on the east side of Tucson at:  
2751 N Soldier Trail  
Tucson, AZ 85749

If driving from the east on I-10, take exit 275 on to Houghton Road. After 13 miles on Houghton, turn right on Tanque Verde Road. After 1.9 miles, make a left onto N Soldier Trail. In 0.5 miles, turn left into the driveway with the NOLS Southwest placard.

If driving from the west on I-10, take exit 256 toward Grant Road and turn left onto W Grant Road. After 8.5 miles, turn left onto E Tanque Verde Road. After 6.8 miles, turn left onto N Soldier Trail. After 0.5 miles, turn left into the driveway with the NOLS Southwest placard.

If flying, Uber, Lyft, and Taxis are available to transport to the campus. The average cost for this trip is between \$25-\$35.

To reach the camping and parking area, make the first left turn off of the main driveway. There will be a few picnic tables and numbered campsites on the sides of an open parking area. Look for a sign pointing toward "WFR Parking"
