Travel, Lodging & Meals

Travel to the McCall Field Campus via Highway 55. When in McCall, turn east on Railroad Ave; turn north at the stop sign on Davis; go through the stop sign on Lick Creek and drive into Ponderosa State Park. Stop at the Park Kiosk and tell the attendant you are going to MOSS. Continue straight and you will see signage for our driveway on the left.

Lodging and Meals are not available for the December 2021 course. Ponderosa State Park, The North Fork Lodge and area hotels may have available lodging. There is a 1-hour lunch break each day. Participants can bring a field lunch to eat on campus or drive 1 mile back to town for local options. McCall has just one fast food vendor: Subway.

Cancellation Policies

A full refund will be given if we cancel the course. If a participant cancels or withdraws from the course:

- Greater than or equal to 30 days prior to the course start date, the McCall Field Campus will retain a \$50.00 administrative fee. The remainder of tuition collected will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of the course start date, tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Once the course begins, no refunds will be awarded. All course registrations are non-transferable.

Outdoor learning in December in McCall will be wet. This is an indoor/outdoor class, no matter the weather conditions. Come to class with warm layers and multiples of waterproof outerwear and footwear. We suggest swapping out wet for dry gear throughout the day. Having different indoor and outdoor shoes may reduce sweaty feet which become cold feet. Consider bringing a ground pad for your use as a rescuer (the patients will be on NOLS provided pads). Essentially, plan for this course as if you will be outside in the cold, rain and slush for 9 hours straight. Our 5 year old students can do it and so can you!
