Meals and Lodging

There is no meals or lodging package available for this course. There are many great campgrounds near Parkdale, some are within walking distance to the classroom, others 10-15 miles away. There is also free camping on forest service roads if you're equipped to camp that way. Hotels and airbnbs are available in Hood River (14 miles). Cooper Spur resort also offers lodging up on the mountain nearby.

Camping:

Most nearby campsites are closed November 1.

You can boondock in Snow Parks and Little John is the nearest to the course.

You can also sometimes find dispersed camping throughout Mt Hood National Forest.

Travel:

The course is just 14 miles from Hood River and 3 miles from the town of Parkdale. This course is being held at the [Mt Hood Town Hall](#). From Hood River, drive south on OR-25 for approximately 14 miles. The town hall will be on your left.

If you cancel or withdraw from a course:

- Greater than or equal to 30 days prior to the course start date, Pacific Wilds will retain a \$35.00 administrative fee and refund your deposit/tuition.
