#### Meals and Lodging

#### Whitman students:

The residence halls are technically closed during Spring Break, but Residence Life is usually able to make student housing available. However, they have less staff on hand, and so must consolidate students together, which may mean you do not get to stay in your own room. Contact Residence Life if you are interested in on campus housing during the WFR. Otherwise, students can reach out on their own to upperclassmen that have off campus housing and make arrangements on their own. You can also get a list of fellow students enrolled in the class from the OP Director to see if anyone else in the WFR course can help you with lodging.

#### Non-Whitman students:

There is no lodging provided for the March WFR courses.

Sweet Basil: pizza place, sell slices and whole pizzas. S. 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. off Main St.

# **Student Logistics**

The Outdoor Program Rental Shop is located in the lower level of the Reid Campus Center next to the Post Office.

**From the West**: Take Highway 12 to Walla Walla. Take the Clinton Street exit, continue straight through the light at Isaacs and after 3 blocks you will come to Boyer Ave. Turn right on Boyer Ave, drive 4 more blocks to Park Street. The Reid Campus Center is the large brick building on the Southwest corner of the intersection of Boyer and Park Street. The Ballroom is on the main floor. ### Registration

Whitman Students: The registrar's office will handle all Whitman student registrations for this class. Whitman students can register any time during the fall semester registration period for this class (SSRA 242B) with the registrar's office since this class will occur in January before the spring semester begins. Registration is handled on a first come first served basis. Make sure to register for the correct section! There are 2 courses- 1 in January and 1 in March!

**Community Members/Non-Whitman Students:** There are several spaces reserved for non Whitman students for the January WFR course. If spaces remain available after student registration takes place, non-Whitman student registration will remain open until all spots are filled. Registration for these spaces is handled by the Whitman College Outdoor Program Rental Shop on a first come first served basis. A deposit of \$400.00 is required to reserve a space in the course. Tuition balance is due by the first day of the course and is payable by check, credit card (*Visa/MasterCard includes an additional \$20 service fee)*, or cash. Make checks to: **'Whitman College Outdoor Program'**. The tuition fee includes instruction, textbooks, equipment use, certification, and continuing education credits. A full refund will be given if we need to cancel the course for any reason.

### **Cancelation Policies**

If you cancel or withdraws from a course:

- Greater than or equal to 30 days prior to the course start date, NOLS Wilderness Medicine will retain a \$35 administrative fee. The remainder of tuition collected will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of the course start date, tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable
- Once the course begins, no refunds will be awarded.
