- *Directions from Interstate 90:* From Exit 12, take West Jackson Street for 5.4 miles. Turn right on St. Joe Street (at Junek's Motors), go 0.6 miles to Young Center. Park in lot, enter by side (parking lot) doors. Doors will be unlocked Saturday by 7:00 am; rest of workshop weekends by 7:30 am; during weekdays doors open at 5:00 am. The classroom is located on the second floor
