Please be prepared to either make meals at the campground, or buy from the local General Store (within a 10 minute walk of the campground) or eat at Yavapai Lodge or Maswick Lodge. If you are camping, we recommend grocery shopping in Williams or Flagstaff Arizona before arriving at the Park.

Travel

Travel – please be prepared to travel to Grand Canyon National Park, South Rim, in Arizona. This is 1.5 hours North of Flagstaff, Arizona. 3.5 hours North of Phoenix, Arizona and 4 hours East of Las Vegas.

Grand Canyon National Park requires a \$35 entrance fee (7 day pass) or the Annual National Park Pass/America the Beautiful Pass. If you are a veteran, have a permanent disability, or active military,

please note you can ask for a free annual or lifetime pass, depending on circumstances. This is up to you to do so at the front entrance.
