This 48-hour course takes place over five days. You are encouraged to bring both your own lunch and dinner on days 3 and 4 because class will be taught in the evenings.

Dec. 5: 8am-5pm (lunch: noon-1pm); 5:30pm-9pm night rescue scenario.

### Meals and Lodging

### Travel

If flying into Alaska for this course please arrive one day before the course begins- it is realistic to catch a redeye the same night as the last day of the course (for example 1am on December 6th).

### Covid Policy

All students are required to show proof of vaccination at check-in. If you are not vaccinated please reach out to NOLS to cancel your registration. Medical grade masks and other personal protective equipment will be provided.

### Cancellation Policies

Requests for cancellations need to be received by phone or email in the timeframe outlined below:

- 30-days or more prior the start date: **\$50 fee** charged & balance of tuition refunded.
- 14-29 days prior the start date: **\$100 fee** for multi-day courses charged & balance of tuition refunded (**1-day courses \$50 fee**)
- 3-13-days prior to start date: We will **refund 50% of your tuition** for all courses. This includes if a student has a cancellation due to the impacts of Covid.
- Cancellations made within 72-hours of the class start time will receive no refund.
