Whitman students:

Registration

How to Register

Whitman Students: The registrar's office will handle all Whitman student registrations for this class. Whitman students can register any time during the fall semester registration period for this class (SSRA 242B) with the registrar's office since this class will occur in January before the spring semester begins. Registration is handled on a first come first served basis. Make sure to register for the correct section! There are 2 courses- 1 in January and 1 in March!

Community Members/Non-Whitman Students: There are several spaces reserved for non Whitman students for the March WFR course. After student registration period ends in mid November, any remaining spots are first come first serve. A deposit of \$400.00 is required to reserve a space in the course. Tuition balance is due by the first day of the course and is payable by check, credit card (Visa/MasterCard), or cash. Make checks to: 'Whitman College Outdoor Program'.

The tuition fee includes instruction, textbooks, equipment use, certification, and continuing education credits. A full refund will be given if we need to cancel the course for any reason.

Cancelation Policies

If you cancel or withdraws from a course:

- Greater than or equal to 30 days prior to the course start date, NOLS Wilderness Medicine will retain a \$35 administrative fee. The remainder of tuition collected will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of the course start date, tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable
- Once the course begins, no refunds will be awarded.
