Travel

The Mountain Center

1. From highway 285/84 north, take the first Tesuque exit
2. At the end of the exit ramp/stop sign, turn right onto CO Rd 73
3. Follow CO Rd 73 approx. 1.5 miles to the Tesuque Village Market, which will be on the right
4. Take a right turn immediately past the Market
5. At the Stop sign, take another right (this is Bishop's Lodge road)
6. Approx. 1/4 mile on right you will see the "The Mountain Center" sign
7. Take a right turn into the driveway
8. Drive down driveway bearing left at small fork in the road
9. Main building is on the right
10. Park in parking lot & come on in.
