

Wilderness First Responder- Hybrid Course (WFR)

This 48-hour course takes place over five days. You are encouraged to bring both your own lunch and dinner on days 2 and 4 because class will be taught in the evenings.

March 4: 8am-5pm (lunch: noon-1pm); 5:30pm-9pm night rescue scenario.

There is not a meals and lodging package available for this course. Students are required to arrange all lodging and food. There are lots of restaurants, cabin rentals, and a general store in downtown Talkeetna. It will be important to secure lodging early because March gets booked early from Iditarod tourism.

If flying into Alaska for this course please arrive one day before the course begins- it is realistic to catch a redeye the same night as the last day of the course (for example 1am on March 6th). If you are flying from out of state there is no public transportation to Talkeetna. You are encouraged to rent a car or we can connect you with local students for carpooling opportunities.
