Travel, Meals, and Lodging

Meals and Lodging

Lunch will be provided on campus for the duration of the course. This is included in your tuition.

Students are responsible for breakfast and dinner. Please email pacific_northwest@nols.edu if you have any dietary needs we should be aware of. In the email, let us know when your course starts as well.

Camping is available at the NOLS PNW campus (the course site) for \$15 a night per person for the duration of the course. If you choose to camp, and plan on arriving the night before the course, please plan to arrive between 4 pm and 8 pm the day before the course begins. If you will not be able to arrive by 8pm, please plan to arrive the following morning. Please plan to leave after class on the final day of class. Camping is not available the night after the course ends.

Not all parking areas at the PNW campus are conducive to sleeping in cars. Please bring a tent to camp in the designated camping area. Since we can't guarantee you flat sleeping space, RVs and camper vans are not allowed. Included with camping is use of WiFi, restrooms, outdoor sinks, and shower facilities. There is no access to kitchen or laundry facilities. All cooking must be done on a camp stove. No campfires. Picnic tables are available for meal preparation.
