Exit 6th Ave and head east on 19th street until the roundabout. Take the 3rd exit onto Elm Street and continue until you see a climbing boulder on your right. That is the Student Rec Center. Go in the main doors NOT the doors with 'Outdoor Recreation Center' above them. Classroom is on that level on the left of the main hallway 150 feet from the entrance.

Parking

Parking is to the west of the building and free on the weekends. An email will be sent to you from Mines Parking in the weeks before the course to purchase a discounted weekly pass for the course duration.
