 - Turn right onto 9th Street

How to Register

To register for the class for the WFR certification only: Students can register online at <u>https://cwcwfr.eventbrite.com</u>. Payment is due at the time of registration.

If a student wishes to avoid paying the registration service fees, they can register and pay for the class by calling CWC Lander at 307-332-3394 or stopping by their office.

To register for the class to receive CWC credit in addition to the WFR certification: If you have not completed the standard <u>CWC application for admission</u>, please do so. It asks when the course is being held; the WFR is part of the Spring 2024 course offerings. When asked about the course of study, select from the drop down, "I only need one course."
