#### Travel

##### Directions to Course

- From the West or East(Chicago/Jackson or Ann Arbor/Detroit Metro Airport)
  - o Take I-94 to exit 162. Turn right onto Jackson Rd toward Old US-12. Continue on E Old US-12 (2.4 mi). Turn right onto Main St S(M-52, 2.2 mi)). Take 1<sup>st</sup> exit on roundabout onto Werkner Rd (2.3 mi). Continue onto Island Lake Rd (0.3 mi). Continue onto Stofer Rd (1.1 mi). Continue onto Hadley Rd (2.7 mi). Turn Right onto Bartell Rd. The site will be ½ mile down the road on the left side.
- From the North (Lansing)
  - o Take I-96 E to Exit 122 toward Webberville/M-43/M-52. Turn right onto N M-52 (take for 15 mi) Continue onto E Main St M-106 (4.3 mi). Turn Right onto Williamsville Rd (2.9 mi). Turn right onto Unadilla Rd. Turn Left onto Kaiser Rd. Continue onto Hadley Rd (1.4 mi). Turn left onto Bartell Rd.
- From the South (Toledo OH)
  - o Take I-75 N. Take exit 20 towards Flint onto I-275 N. Take exit 17 toward Chicago onto I-94 W. Follow I-94 W to exit 162 and then follow directions from above.
