Meals and Lodging

There will be no food service available on campus during the course. If you live on campus you may be able to stay in your residence hall room for the duration of the WFR course starting January 9th, and no sooner. If you do not live on campus you are responsible for your own lodging during the course. Residence Life would like you to know that during the WFR cooking in residence halls is discouraged. The Glover Alston Center (GAC) on Boyer Ave (1/2 block from downtown) will be open and available for preparing and eating meals. Students are highly encouraged to use this space for cooking if staying on campus.

Please be respectful of this space. Clean up after yourself and put away any dishes etc that you use. And as a reminder, NO parties, events, or guests while staying in residence halls. Residence life staff will be very limited at this time and you will need to be responsible for yourself. Please be aware that any misuse of the residence halls will reflect poorly on the Outdoor Program and will impact our ability to house students in residence halls during future WFR courses.

Travel

From the West: Take Highway 12 to Walla Walla. Take the Clinton Street exit, continue straight through the light at Isaacs and drive 3 blocks to Stop sign. Turn right on Boyer Ave, drive 4 blocks to Park Street. The Reid Campus Center is the large brick building on the left (Southwest corner) of the intersection of Boyer and Park Street. From the South: Take Route 125 until you intersect hwy 12, then follow the directions above. The Outdoor Program Rental Shop is located in the lower level of the Reid Campus Center next to the Post Office.

Registration

Whitman Students: The registrar's office will handle all Whitman student registrations for this class. Whitman students can register any time during the fall semester registration period for this class (SSRA 242A) with the registrar's office since this class will occur in January before the spring semester begins.
