PLACES TO EAT

Colville Street Patisserie 40 S. Colville (Great desserts, baked goods)

The Green Lantern 1606 E Isaacs Ave (Great fish tacos, pizza, full menu)

Walla Walla Indian Cuisine 12 E Main St. Walla Walla

Wingmanz: Main St. about 2 blocks from campus. Great wings, burgers, salads.

Coffee Places: **Livit Coffee**: Isaacs Ave., **Roastery**: by airport, **Coffee Perk**: S. 1st/Main St.

Thai Ploy (good thai food; take out only on Spokane St.)

Phoumy's (good thai food; take out of eat in on Isaac's Ave)

Sweet Basil: slices and whole pizzas. S. 1st Ave. off Main St. ; **Fiasco Pizza**: really good pizza, more expensive. Downtown on main st.

Travel

From the West: Take Route 12 to Walla Walla. Take the Clinton Street exit, continue straight through the light at Isaacs and after 3 blocks you will come to Boyer Ave. Turn right on Boyer Ave, drive 4 more blocks to Park Street. The Reid Campus Center is the large brick building on the SW corner of the intersection of Boyer and Park Street. The Ballroom is on the main floor. The college address is 345 Boyer Ave, Walla Walla, WA, 99362.

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From the South: Take Route 125 until you intersect Route 12, follow directions above. The Rental Shop is located on the lower level of the Reid Campus Center.

Registration

Payment in full is required to reserve your spot in the course. **Payment and registration for the course happens through the Outdoor Program Compass online portal.** Whitman College students can register and pay with credit card, student charge and/or BCOF funds. Community members can register on Compass and pay with credit card. Payment with check or cash is available, but will require contacting the Rental Shop directly at 509-527-5965. The tuition fee includes instruction, textbooks, equipment use, certification, and continuing education credits. A full refund will be given if we need to cancel the course for any reason.

Cancellation Policies

If you cancel or withdraw from a course:

- Greater than or equal to 30 days prior to the course start date, NOLS Wilderness Medicine will retain a \$35 administrative fee. The remainder of tuition will be refunded.
- Within 30 days of the course start date, tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable
- Once the course begins, no refunds will be awarded.
