Lodging

Purchasing the lodging option is a convenient option to consider. It allows you to stay on the same campus where the course is held. Lodging is double occupancy in rooms with private bathrooms. We do not permit sleeping in vehicles or campers in our campus parking lots. There are free, dispersed [National Forest campsites](#) outside of town, and fee-based sites in [Bridger Teton National Forest](#) and [Grand Teton National Park](#).
