The class will be held in the USFS Auditorium behind the Mammoth Lakes Welcome Center. Address is: 2510 Main St, Mammoth Lakes, CA 93546. From Highway 295, take Highway 203 west for 5 minutes and you will see signs for the Mammoth Lakes Welcome Center on your right. Park in the lot for the Welcome Center and enter the USFS office from the north side of the building.
