Travel, Meals, and Lodging

Meals

There are no meals or lodging available for this course. Students are required to arrange all of their own meals. The office has a fridge and microwave. There are also shops and cafes in walking distance such as Cool River and The Crown, and City Market is about 1 mile from town.

Lodging

There are a multitude of lodging options varying in cost and amenities throughout the county. You may find less expensive options in Frisco and Silverthorne than Breckenridge but there are a lot of options to choose from. Camping this time of year is limited as there is most likely still snow on the ground and campgrounds are not yet open. Feel free to contact our office with specific lodging questions.

Travel

Breckenridge can be accessed via Hwy 9 either traveling from the North or the South. If coming from I70, take the Frisco exit off I70 and drive South for 10 miles on Hwy 9.

This class will take place at our *Adaptive Ski Office* on the Breckenridge Ski Resort. The address is [655 South Park Avenue, Breckenridge CO, 80424](#). The office is at the base of Peak 9, and we are located below the Maggie restaurant. Our office is located in a courtyard setting, requiring that you park in a nearby lot and walk, rather than parking directly at the office.

It is important that you use this address! If you google map our name you have a 1 in 3 chance to get the correct location for the class, BOEC has 3 locations in Breckenridge.

Parking

There are few options you can choose from for parking. Included are some notes about these options as well as added a [Breck Park Map](#) to help you reference these locations.

- **F Lot** - This is a pay lot, but the closest place to park. Cost on the weekends is \$22.00 per day. (If you park here make sure you pay or you will most likely be ticketed). From F Lot you will need to cross Park Avenue and walk towards The Village, through the courtyard to the steps just adjacent to the Maggie Building. Go down the steps and turn right to find signs to the BOEC ski office.
- **Ice Rink Lot** - This lot is free, from here you can either walk about 0.6 miles to the office, or ride the yellow or blue bus route to Park Ave Lofts stop. From here, you will need to cross Park Avenue and walk towards The Village, through the courtyard to the steps just adjacent to the Maggie Building. Go down the steps and turn right to find signs to the BOEC ski office.
