Personal Vehicles

The conditions of the highways that cross the mountains vary at this time of year. The roads across the Coastal Mountains (Hwy 20; Hwy 18) are curvy and can be icy, especially early in the morning.

If your drive brings you over the Cascade Mountains (Hwy20 and Hwy 26) be prepared for sections that require chains - slow, snowy and icy conditions. Consider an alternative route using I-84 to Portland and back down, or route up through California and I-5. Check www.tripcheck.com for the latest conditions.

Airports, & Shuttles

From Eugene:

The nearest commercial airport (2 hours) is in Eugene, Oregon. It has cars for rent, but there is no direct shuttle from EUG to Newport.

From Portland:

Portland Airport is 3-4 hours away, depending on traffic. It has cars for rent, and there is a shuttle from PDX to the South Beach Fish Market. (5min walk)
