Anza-Borrego Desert State Park:

Anza-Borrego Desert State Park (ABDSP) is the largest state park in California and one of the largest desert protected areas in the west. Located in the eastern half of San Diego County, the Park extends roughly 25 miles east to west and 50 miles north to south and encompasses 615,000 acres with 12 wilderness areas and over 100 miles of hiking trails. The Park is known for its sweeping vistas and unique rock formations, palm groves, wildflowers, and species such as the bighorn sheep. It's the perfect setting for learning and testing life-saving wilderness skills.

Travel, Meals, and Lodging

Meals and Lodging

Lodging is available at the <u>Steele/Burnand Anza-Borrego Desert Research Center</u> (SBABDRC). SBABDRC is an 88-acre property that lies on the western edge of the Colorado Subdivision of the Sonoran Desert in eastern San Diego County. SBABDRC is housed in a former country club and is located adjacent to the State Park in the town of Borrego Springs. An agreement with Anza-Borrego Desert State Park and Anza-Borrego Foundation makes SBABDRC available to support ABF's public education programs.

Amenities at SBABDRC include four private rooms with bathrooms, four dorm rooms with a total of 24 bunk beds and two shared bathrooms, a large event space, a classroom, a lab, a shared kitchen, and an outdoor patio. Registration with lodging for this course includes a bed in a shared dorm room and full use of the facility's shared restrooms (with showers) and fully equipped kitchens. Participants should bring their own bedding, toiletries, and food but may use kitchen appliances and refrigerators/freezers.
