Travel, Meals, and Lodging

Meals and Lodging

There is not a meals and lodging package available for this course. Students are required to arrange all lodging and food.

Meals During the Course:

The course location is fairly remote. It is recommended to pack a lunch each day. The lodge where the course will be held has a kitchen with a refrigerator, microwave, water fountain, coffee machine, and hot water for tea that students are welcome to use.

Limited restaurants to purchase lunch during the course include:

- Dones Bones Barbecue: 5 miles away
- Couches Subs & Grocery: 9 miles away
- Sheetz: 10 miles away

Lodging Options in the Area:

Stone Valley Recreation Area Cabins: Onsite accommodation is located 3.5 miles away on the other side of Lake Perez via the East Entrance. 20–30-minute walk via the Lake Trail to the Civil Engineering Lodge and classroom. Small one-room cabins with electricity, refrigerator, and microwave. Centralized shower house with restrooms and showers onsite. Special HWRR course rate of \$56 per night. Travel


The Stone Valley Recreation Area operated by Penn State University is located approximately 14 miles South of State College Pennsylvania. The course will be held at the Civil Engineering Lodge (CE Lodge), which can be accessed via the West Entrance of the recreation area off of Charter Oak Rd. (Route 305)

From the North via State College area: Take route 26 South at Pine Grove Mills, over the mountain. At the base of the mountain make a right onto Charter Oak Rd (Rt. 305 West). Travel on Charter Oak Rd. approximately 3 miles. Take a left at the Stone Valley Recreation Area West Entrance onto Lodge Ln.

From the South via Huntingdon area: Take route 26 North towards State College. Make a left onto Charter Oak Rd.(Rt. 305 West) at the base of the mountain. Travel on Charter Oak Rd. approximately 3 miles. Take a left at the Stone Valley Recreation Area West Entrance onto Lodge Ln.

From the West via Altoona area: Take route 22 East towards Huntingdon. Make a left onto route 305 East at Alexandria. Travel on route 305 East (Charter Oak Rd) approximately 13 miles to the Stone Valley Recreation Area West Entrance. Turn right onto Lodge Ln.
