



- ICE: U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement
- CBP: U.S. Customs and Border Protection
- ATF: Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives
- HSI: Homeland Security Investigations
- DEA: Drug Enforcement Administration
- FBI: Federal Bureau of Investigation
- NATIONAL GUARD: State military force, often deployed for border or emergency operations
- NPS: National Park Service, manages public lands and parks
