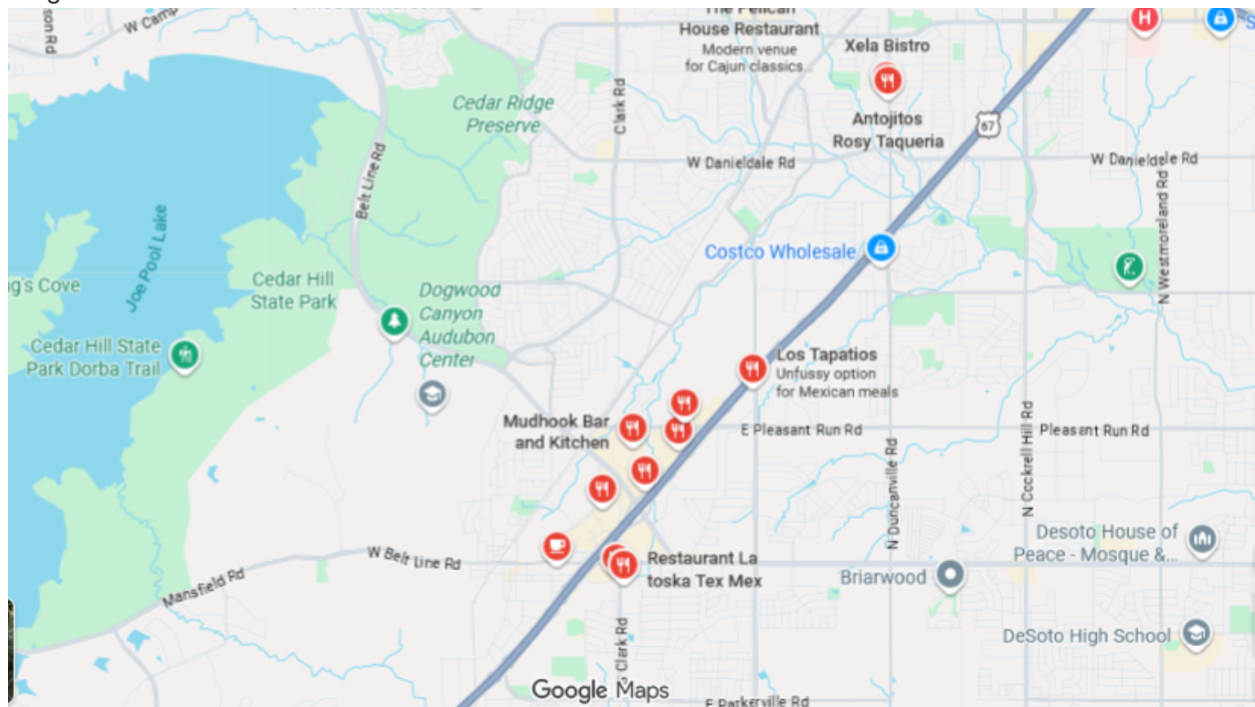

Meals and Lodging

Cedar Ridge Preserve is located in the southwest corner of Dallas. There will be snacks and coffee/tea provided for participants, but no full lunch. We recommend either packing a lunch or buying lunch nearby. There are some places close by on wheatland road or you can explore the large variety of restaurants close to the Cedar Hill core around 10 minutes away. There is a microwave onsite open for participant usage.



This course does not include lodging. Participants will need to make accommodations independently. Consider one of the hotels close to the town center of Cedar Hill. Cedar Hill State Park is also less than 10 minutes away. There are campsites available there as well.

Travel

The preserve can be reached most easily through Interstate highway 20 from the north or route 67 from the east. It is about 25 minutes from DFW airport and 30 minutes from Lovefield airport. It is recommended to arrive by car.
